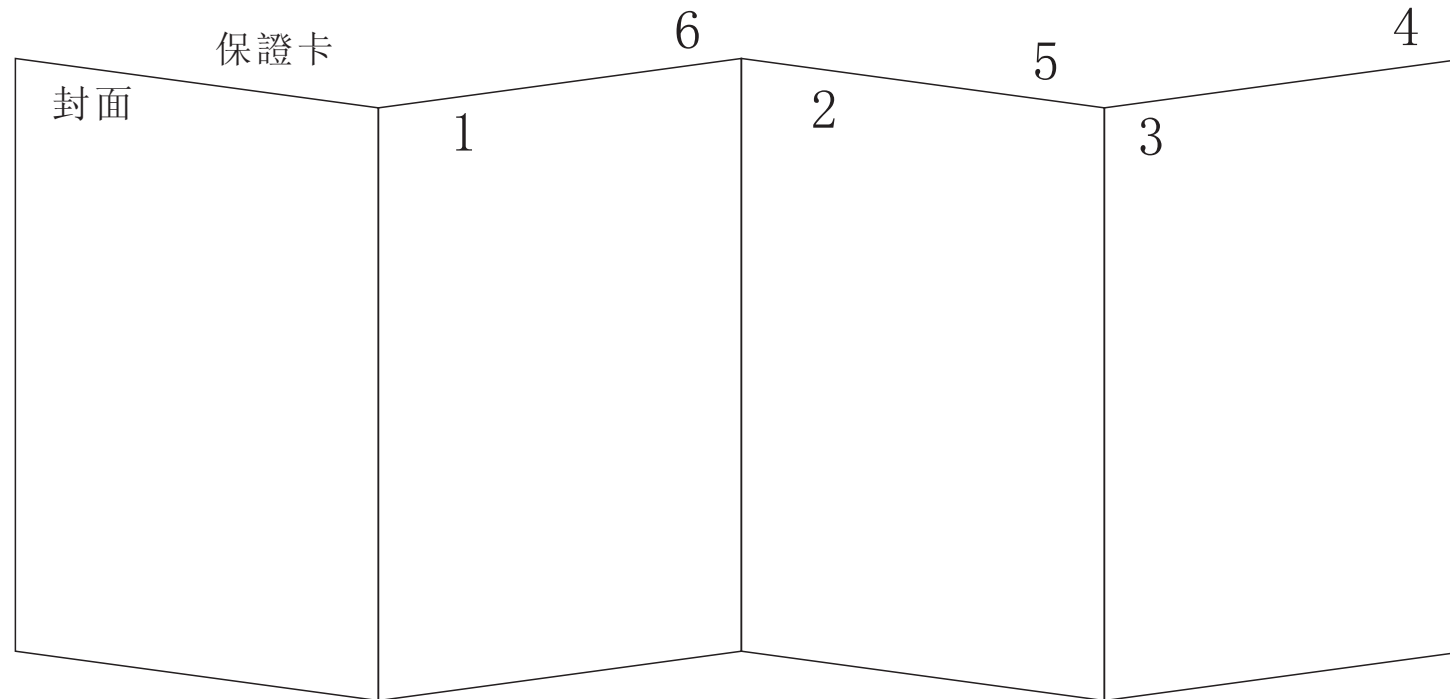

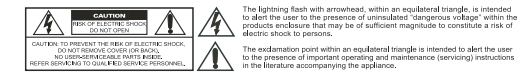

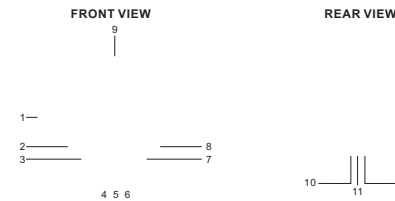

### CONTROL FUNCTIONS

1. ⏻ / SOURCE  
**Power:** Press to power on the speaker; press and hold to turn off / standby the unit.  
**Source:** Press to change between audio sources, IPOD-RADIO-AUX.
2. SET / ▶  
**In iPod mode:** press to play or pause the track.  
**In Standby mode:** press to set the clock time.  
**In FM Radio mode:** press and hold to save the current radio station as a preset station. (20 preset modes)  
**In Radio mode:** press to play the preset station.
3. ◀  
**iPod mode:** Play the previous track.  
**Radio mode:** Search the lower range of radio channels Search for a lower.  
**Stand-by mode:** Decreases the hour or minute.
4. ▶  
**iPod mode:** Play the next track.  
**Radio mode:** Search the upper range of radio channels.  
**Stand-by mode:** Increases the hour or minute.
5. VOL+ : Press to increase the volume.  
When the speaker is turned off, press to set the alarm.
6. VOL- : Press to increase the volume.  
When the speaker is turned off, press to set the alarm.
7. SNOOZE : When the alarm sounds, press the SNOOZE button to activate the snooze function. The alarm will stop and will sound again in 9 minutes.

### POWER ON/ OFF THE SPEAKER

**Use ONE of the following options to power the speaker:**  
**AC Adapter (Power Outlet)**  
Connect the power adaptor cord into the DC jack of the speaker, then plug the power adaptor into a power outlet.  
Press (⏻ / SOURCE) button to power on the speaker. Press and hold the button to turn off the speaker.

**Batteries**  
Insert 6 x AA batteries (not included) as illustrated into the battery compartment. Press (⏻ / SOURCE) button to power on the speaker.

**Note:**  
All 6xAA batteries are required in order for the speaker to operate normally. If there is a power shortage, the inner 2 AA batteries will act as a backup source to prevent the loss of display time and settings during power failure.  
When using batteries, the charging function of the speaker will not charge your iPod or iPhone. Must use the power adapter (included) for charging.

### SETTING THE CLOCK (STANBY mode)

- To set the clock, turn off the speaker by pressing and holding down the (⏻ / SOURCE) button.
- Press [Set/▶] button to enter into clock setting mode.
  - Press the [◀] or [▶] button to adjust up and down the hour.
  - Press [Set] to confirm hour.
  - Press the [◀] or [▶] button to adjust up and down the minutes.
  - Press [Set] to confirm the time.
  - The time format is a 12 hour format. For evening hours adjust up or down the clock until the pm indicator is shown as a dot in between the hour and minutes (refer to picture).
  - The speaker system has a time sync function with iPod or iPhone. When you dock your

iPod or iPhone in the cradle, the speaker will automatically sync the clock time with your iPod or iPhone. Please note this function will not work with older iPods or iPhones (reference to package for compatible iPod and iPhone models).



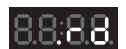
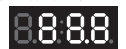
### SETTING THE ALARM (STANBY mode)

- To set the alarm, turn off the speaker by pressing and holding down the (⏻ / SOURCE) button.
- Press and hold down [Vol-] or [Vol+] button for 2 seconds, the alarm time will flash.
  - Press [◀] or [▶] button to adjust up and down the alarm hour.
  - Press [Vol-] or [Vol+] to confirm hour.
  - Press the [◀] or [▶] button to adjust up and down the alarm minutes.
  - Press [Vol-] or [Vol+] to confirm the alarm time.
  - The time format is a 12 hour format. For evening hours adjust up or down the time until the pm indicator is shown as a dot in between the hours and minutes (refer to picture).



### ALARM SOURCE

Make sure the speaker is still in OFF or standby mode in order to turn on the alarm source. Press [Vol-] or [Vol+] button repeatedly to select between the alarm source, OFF-bu-rd-IPOD.



If iPod is selected and iPod is not connected, when the alarm sounds it will automatically switch to buzzer sound

Select your choice of alarm source and remain on the display, after 3 seconds the alarm source is set. When the alarm is set, the display will show the alarm indicator which is a dot in between the 2 digit hour time. To cancel or turn off the alarm, follow instructions for Setting the Alarm. Press [Vol-] or [Vol+] button to select alarm source to OFF, the alarm indicator will turn off.



### ALARM OPERATION

When the alarm sounds, the alarm indicator will flash and the volume will increase gradually. It will continue to sound and last for one hour. To stop the alarm, press the (⏻ / SOURCE) button. The alarm indicator will remain illuminated and the alarm will sound again at the same time the following day. To snooze, press [SNOOZE] button to activate snooze function, the alarm will sound again approximately after nine minutes. To cancel the alarm, follow instructions for Setting the Alarm. Press [Vol-] or [Vol+] button to select alarm source to OFF, the alarm indicator will turn off.

### USING THE IPOD/IPHONE

- Turn on the speaker system by holding the (⏻ / SOURCE) button Insert your iPod or iPhone into the docking.
- Press (⏻ / SOURCE) button until the display shows IPOD.
  - Press the [▶] button to play or pause the docked iPod or iPhone.
  - Press [▶] or [◀] button to play the previous or next track.
  - To fast forward or rewind, press and hold down [▶] or [◀] buttons respectively when playing.
  - Adjust the volume using the [VOL-] or [VOL+] buttons.

**Note:**  
The iPod or iPhone will charge when using AC power adapter during standby or power on mode. The clock will automatically sync to the time of the docked iPod or iPhone. Auto time sync will not work with some older model iPods. (Reference package for compatible model) It is advisable to avoid charging the iPod when listening to the radio as it may interfere with the radio reception.

### SETTING THE RADIO

- Turn on the speaker, then press (⏻ / SOURCE) button repeatedly until the FM frequency is shown on the display.
- To search radio stations automatically, press and hold the [▶] button or [◀] button for a few seconds. The radio will start navigating up or down the radio frequency. When a radio station is located, the search will stop.
- To manually tune the radio, press the [▶] or [◀] button each repeatedly until desired station is located.
- Extend or move the antenna for best frequency reception.
- Adjust the volume by pressing the [VOL-] or [VOL+] buttons.

### PRE-SET RADIO STATIONS

The system has 20 pre-set radio functions that can be programmed First, search and locate the FM station you desired.

- Press and hold the [SET/▶] button for 2 seconds until the display flashes preset channel number "PXX" (XX represent channel number 01 to 20).
- Press [▶] or [◀] buttons to select pre-set number from 1 to 20.
- Press [SET/▶] button to save the radio station as pre-set station.
- Repeat the above steps to further store other pre-set FM stations.
- After you have saved the pre-set stations, press the [SET/▶] button to select to listen to the desired pre-set FM station.

### CONNECTING TO OTHER AUDIO SOURCES

The system is compatible to play other audio sources such as MP3 player, portable CD player or other auxiliary devices through the AUX IN jack.

- Press the (⏻ / SOURCE) button repeatedly until "AUX" is shown on the display.
- Connect the auxiliary devices using a 3.5mm jack cable into the "AUX IN" jack of the speaker.
- Control the settings directly from the connected auxiliary device to play, pause or adjust the volume.
