

# **Beauty Beatbox**

### **WARNING:**


(1) AC Adaptor (2) Stereo cord

## **Operating Instruction: (By AC Adaptor)**

- 1. Make sure speaker is turned off.
- 2. Insert small end of the enclosed AC adaptor into Adaptor input. Plug the other end of the adaptor into a wall outlet.


**NOTE:** Use only power adaptor with the following specification: Input AC 100-240V 50/60Hz/Output DC5V 300mA

- 3. Plug the stereo cord into headphone jack on your player.
- 4. Play music using player's controls and adjust the volume by using volume control on the back of the box. (NOTE: you may need to experiment to find the right volume setting for the player and/or the speaker set)




## **Operating Instruction: (By Batteries)**

1. Please take out the battery box as photo shown.



2. Insert three new 1.5 volt "AA" batteries (battery is not included) into the box as photo show.



## **Battery safety & Disposal Information**

To avoid explosion or leakage, do not dispose of batteries in a fire or attempt to recharge standard or alkaline batteries.
