

5 Frame Photobox

Note: This item is meant for drywall/wood stud mounting only. If your walls are made from concrete, brick or plaster, please consult your local hardware store for assistance in selecting the appropriate hardware.



TWO Screws TWO Anchors Tools:

Phillips screwdriver, Level, Pencil, Tape, Stud Finder

Mounting Instructions:

- 1. Determine which way, horizontally or vertically you want to mount the product on the wall.
- 2. Hold the template at a desired location on the wall (use a level to ensure the template is level). Tape the template to the wall.
- 3. Using a pencil, mark the wall through the template at the intersection of the X's within the circles on the template. The resulting marks are the insertion points for the mounting hardware. Remove the template from the wall.



Note: If either mark happens to align with a wall stud (use a stud finder to determine this), do not use the provided anchors because they cannot penetrate wood. If a mark does align with a stud, only use one of the provided screws at this mark. Use the screwdriver to secure a screw at the mark directly into the wall and stud. Rotate the screw clockwise until the screw head is about 3/8" from the wall.

- 4) For marks that do not align with a wall stud: Place a Phillips screwdriver into the recess of an anchor and position its tip at one of the insertion point marks. Push the anchor into the wall as you rotate it clockwise. The anchor will drive itself into the wall like a large screw. Continue rotating until the wide end of the anchor is even with the wall. Repeat this step with the other anchor and insertion point.
- 5) Secure a provided screw into each installed anchor. Use the screwdriver to rotate the screw clockwise until the screw head is about 3/8" from the wall.
- 6) Perhaps with the help of another person, hold the item against the wall so that each keyhole bracket receives the head of each screw protruding from the wall. Lower the item down to engage the brackets to the screws.

Care Instructions:

Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use strong chemical or abrasive cleaners.

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
